HURON NATURAL AREA

HURON TRAIL
1.3km - Asphalt / Stonedust
The Huron Trail provides access to all other trails and the Board of Education Pond. The paved sections are wheelchair accessible.

PLANTATION TRAIL
1.7km - Stonedust / Natural Surface
The Plantation Trail features a series of loops through a forest which was planted in the late 1950s to create habitat from abandoned farm fields.

FOREST TRAIL
1.0km - Natural Surface
The Forest Trail begins at the boardwalk and continues into a mature forest. There are hills and some uneven surfaces. A great place to look for birds and wildflowers.

MEADOW TRAIL
0.6km - Stonedust
The Meadow Trail features a few steep hills but travel is easy. Look for birds and butterflies not found in other areas. There is a viewing and sitting area at the top.

WOODLAND TRAIL
0.8km - Natural Surface
The Woodland Trail is accessed from the Meadow Trail and travels past a series of kettle wetlands into a younger mixed forest. Trail conditions are variable with a few steep hills and uneven terrain.

STRASBURG CREEK TRAIL
2.0km - Asphalt
The Strasburg Creek Trail runs along the south edge of the park with views of the Former Bastler's Pond. A creek crossing provides access to the trails on the north side of the creek.
